6. "Discuss and consider possibly reducing permit and/or construction fees for the new DISD elementary school generally located at Belt Line Road and Goode Road in Wilmer, Texas as part of the Water Line and Sewer Line agreement with the City, DISD, Liberty Crossing, Inc. and Autumn Breeze, Inc."

Shelton Survey, Abstract No. 1285, in the City of Wilmer, Texas (the subject property, is also cited as addresses 3, 4, 1013 and 6 Highview Drive in Dallas County Appraisal District records).
