WILMER ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION (4A)

The Board is composed of five members who serve two-year terms. Members are not required to be residents of the City. The Board administers funds and projects using the ½ cents sales tax receipts dedicated to economic development purposes pursuant to the Development Corporation Act of 1979, Article 5190.6. The 4A Board is commissioned to research and develop a plan for economic development for the City, such plan to be submitted to City Council for approval; to prepare an annual budget for approval by the Council; and to authorize deposits and investment of public funds within the scope of its stewardship.

WILMER COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION (4B)

The seven appointed members serve for a two-year term. The Community Development Corporation administers funds and projects using the ½ cent sales tax to help develop, and undertake projects for quality of life improvements including economic development that will attract and retain primary employers. Funds can be used for a wide variety of projects including land, buildings, and equipment including professional and amateur sports (including children's sports) and athletic facilities, tourism and entertainment facilities, convention and public park purposes and events, (including stadiums, ballparks, and open space improvements). Members must be residents of the City.

WILMER LIBRARY BOARD

The Library Board has five members who serve two-year terms. Members must be residents of Wilmer. The purpose of the Board is to promote public interest in the Library. The Board serves in an advisory capacity.

WILMER PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD

The five members of the Wilmer Parks and Recreation Board are appointed to serve a two-year term. The primary service of this board is to provide opportunities for enriching the lives and meeting the recreational needs of Wilmer citizens. The expressed purpose is to maintain and develop facilities and programs to provide a well rounded, wholesome

program of leisure time activities for the people residing in the community. The Board serves in an advisory capacity.
